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AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 31 March 2017 (Week 39)

The AWEX EMI fell for the first time in nine sales when it finished at 1502¢, 44¢ lower (-2.8%) in Australian currency and 34¢ lower (-2.9%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week

45,203 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 49,214 bales last sale. 16.4% of the offering (including 21.6% of the Merino Fleece) was passed in.

As usual, the Pass-In rate was strongly influenced by the direction of the market. It was only 2.9% when the EMI reached 1500¢ in an upward direction four sales ago.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$62.2 million (\$1,647 per bale).

The easing that commenced on the previous Thursday continued on Wednesday, and accelerated on Thursday. Uniform falls of around 3.5% occurred from 16.5 to 19.5 microns, increasing to around 4.5% from 20 to 22 microns.

However, the season average EMI moved up by 4ϕ to 1373ϕ (as it must do when the spot EMI is higher), the average price per bale was among its highest values for the season and the difference between the 16.5 and 22 micron AWEX MPGs remained at over 1000ϕ .

Other wool types were also affected, of which the smallest changes occurred among the crossbreds up to 30 microns and in the Merino cardings. Members of the trade have commented on the number of lots with high VM levels.

The US Exchange Rate was steady during the week, finishing 0.01¢ (0.0%) higher to close at 76.63¢ on Thursday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India.

Looking ahead the offering for the next sale has lifted to 49,400 bales.

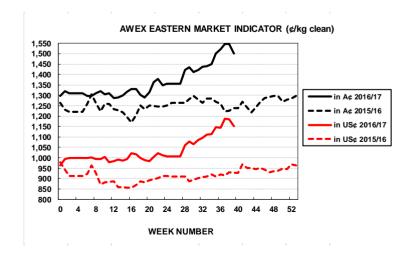

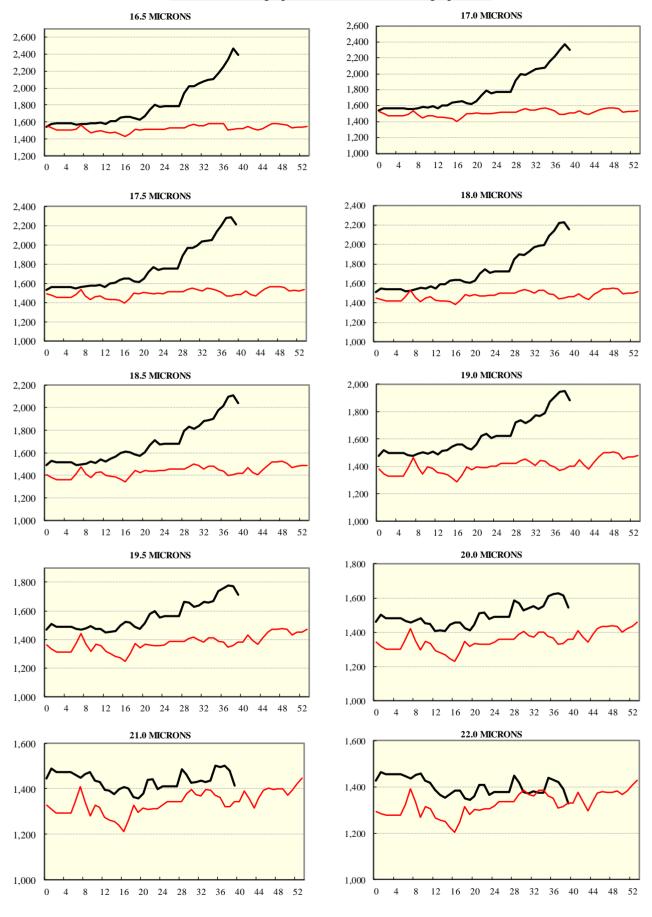
