AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW Week Ending 1 September 2017 (Week 09)

The AWEX EMI finished at 1558¢, 14¢ lower (-0.9%) in Australian currency and 10¢ lower (-0.8%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week.

The WMI eased by 73¢, but this was over a two week period, following the break in sales in the previous week. The EMI eased by 64¢ over the same period.

45,838 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 37,598 bales last sale. 10.0% of the offering was passed in.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$75.3 million (\$1,825 per bale), taking the season total to \$440.6 million.

It was a market of two different days when the EMI eased by a further 23¢ on Wednesday, but then gained 9¢ on Thursday. There were also differences across the micron ranges, with gains at the fine end of the Merinos that progressively changed to falls as the micron value increased.

Crossbred prices eased for the second week in a row, giving back some of the gains from earlier in the season. Their prices are still above where they were at the start of the season.

Merino skirtings followed the fleece types; and oddments settled on Thursday after falls on Wednesday. The average Merino Cardings Price Guide fell by a further 21¢ and is now at 1092¢, 70¢ below the value in the first two weeks of the season.

The US Exchange Rate finished 0.04¢ (0.1%) higher to close at 78.98¢ on Thursday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for India and Europe.

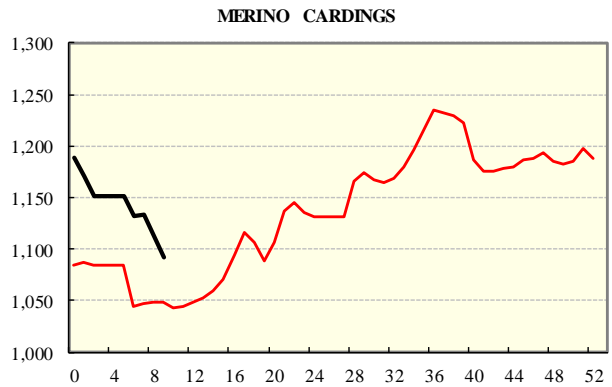
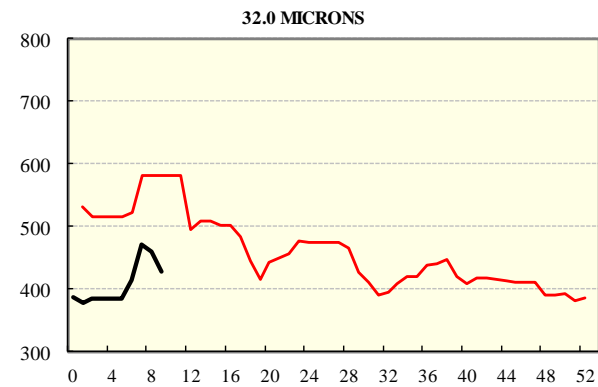
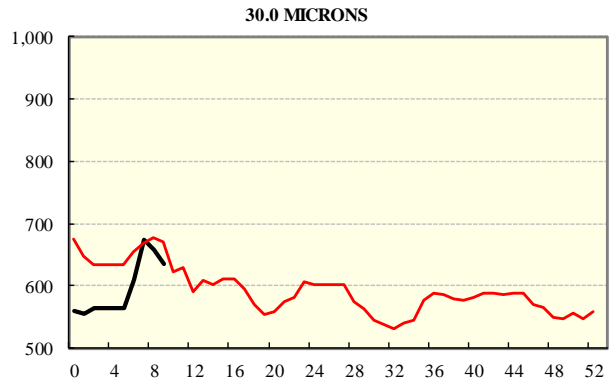
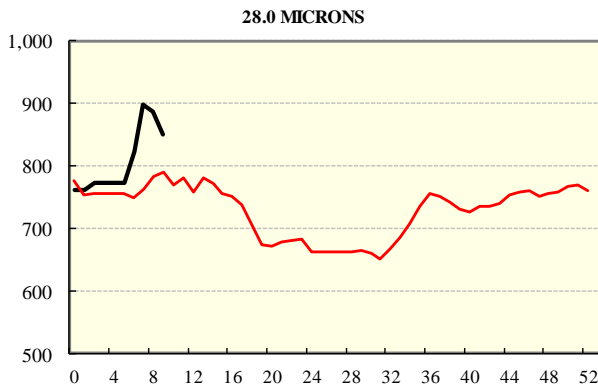
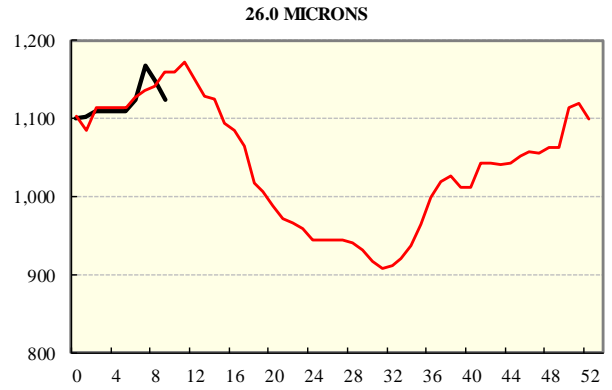
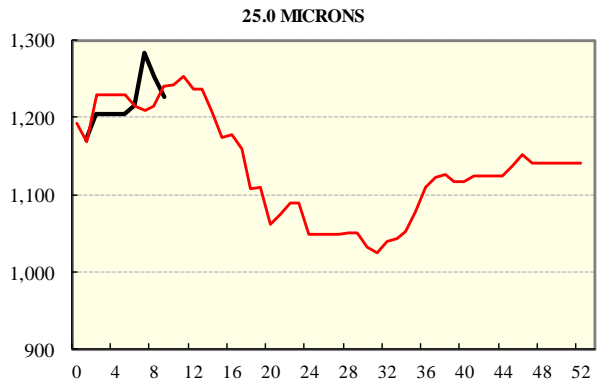
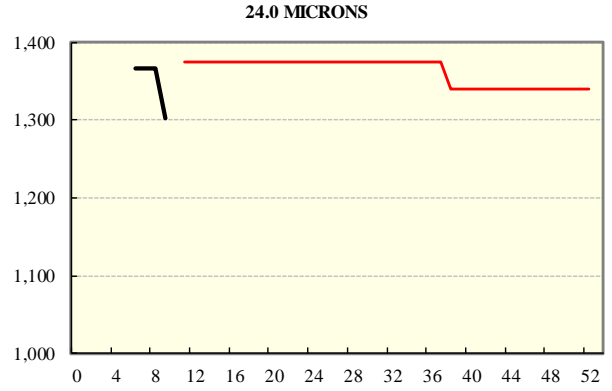
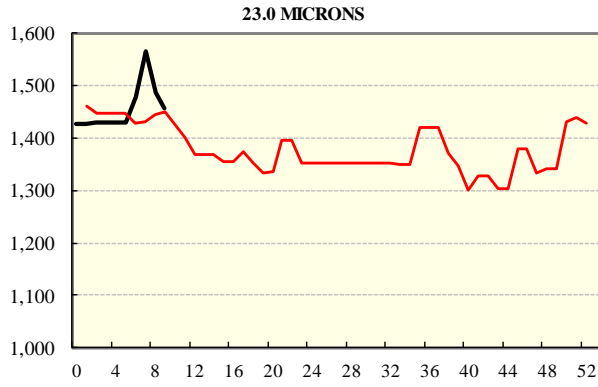
AVERAGE AWEX MICRON PRICE GUIDES

 2017/18(black graph line) and 2016/17 (red graph line)

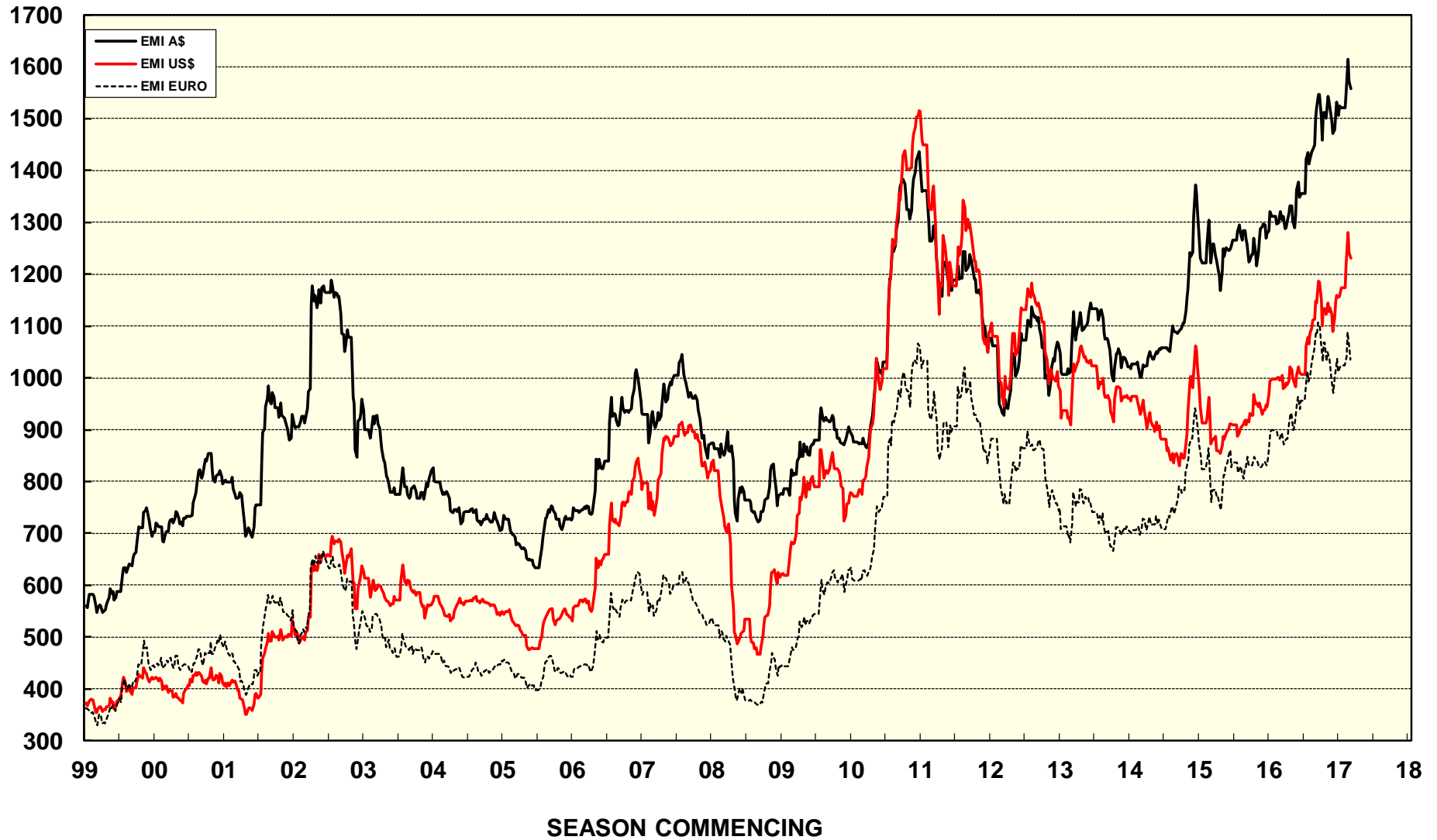


AVERAGE AWEX MICRON PRICE GUIDES
