#### AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 23 March 2018 (Week 38)

The AWEX EMI finished  $27\phi$  higher (+1.5%) in Australian currency and  $2\phi$  lower (-0.1%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week.

38,219 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 42,645 bales last sale. 4.0% of the offering was passed in.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$71.5 million (\$1,948 per bale), taking the season total to \$2.5 billion.

The market started very strongly on Wednesday, with good gains across all micron ranges and wool types that were largely associated with a  $1.8\phi$  fall in the US Exchange Rate. This was followed by moderate falls across the Merino types on Thursday when the US Exchange Rate moved up by  $0.47\phi$ .

The gains among the Merinos were softer at the fine end, but the difference between the average 16.5 and 22 AWEX MPGs remains above  $1100\phi$ 

Crossbreds were mixed, but overall they had a good week; and finished with increases in all of their average AWEX MPGs. Oddments also had a good week, that saw the average Merino Cardings Price Guide move up for the first time in six weeks.

The US Exchange Rate eased all week, before moving up on Thursday. It finished 1.32 ¢ (-1.7%) lower to close at 77.44 ¢ on Thursday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India.

Looking ahead, the coming sale is the last before the one week break in the week after Easter. Both it and the following sale are expected to be in the order of 46,000 bales.




