AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 23 November 2018 (Week 21)

The AWEX EMI followed the previous week's modest 5¢ rise with significant rises on both days, before finishing 77¢ higher (+4.3%) in Australian currency and 51¢ higher (+3.9%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle

30,761 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 35,334 bales last sale. 5.7% of the offering was passed in.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$58.2 million (\$2,007 per bale), taking the season total to \$1.332 billion (\$2,288 per bale).

The New Zealand Merino Company also offered 1,128 bales in Melbourne on Wednesday, of which 9.1% were passed in.

There were gains across all micron ranges and wool types, with the greatest gains being among the fine to medium crossbreds and from 19.5 up among the Merinos. The average AWEX Micron Price Guides moved up by 100¢, or more, for all micron ranges from 19 to 21 microns. Merino Skirtings did well, as did the Oddments, where the average AWEX Merino Cardings Price Guide recovered another 57¢ on top of the previous weeks rise of 89¢.

The US Exchange Rate finished 0.29¢ (-0.4%) lower to close at 72.50¢ on Thursday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India.

Looking ahead, offerings for the coming three sales are expected to range from 36,374 bales to 40,883 bales and to be 23.5% less than in the same period last year. The forecast progressive difference to Week 24 is -18.5%.




